We are looking forward to the New Year beginning with many happy faces returning to school to meet old friends and return to fun activities. We have added several new students to our school in December—Adley Kiser has joined our T-Th One's class with Miss Lorraine. Can you believe that we are already preparing for the school year 2009-2010? We will be continuing with the same staff and excellent curriculum. Our Pre-K program has received "raves" this year in preparing the children for Kindergarten.

We will begin accepting applications for the 2009-2010 school year on January 12 and 13 in my office.

Although we will accept registrations from new families on these dates, priority will be given to current families (including siblings) and church members until January 19. After that, we will start filling spaces with children new to our school. We urge you to register early to insure your child's spot for the days and classes you want. The Two's classes will be particularly full next year since we have 17 one-year-olds to place plus the many new two-year-old children who will be registering. We will add another T-Th Two's class to accommodate all of the toddlers who will be two in September. A teacher and assistant will be in each 1,2,3 and Pre K classrooms.

The registration fee must be included with the application. The Supply Fee is due March 1. The registration form and fee schedule is attached to this Newsletter.
